Treasurer's Report: Glenn Corlew made a presentation of the projected budget for the fiscal year 2001. With corrections, the annual income was tagged at \$3,360, while the expenditures were expected to be \$3,333. The income, however, included transferring \$500 from the savings account. The \$1000 we expect to receive from the profits of last year's FotoClave has prevented an even more drastic depletion of our treasury. A committee will work to find a major well-known presenter for the year 2002. A large turnout of members and other interested photographers for this event will help create a profit that can be used to offset future expenses.

A new and elegant **N4C Judges List** was handed out; the work was completed by our secretary, Carol Hemingway.

Judging Seminar: The purported Judges Seminar to be given by Fran Cox was aborted due to lack of interest among her council members (6Cs). However, the interest is high in N4C and we will pursue the seminar, initially by finding an inexpensive venue. Vice president Trenkins McLain has volunteered for this task.

All ribbons and medals from the **Annual Competition** have been handed out.


Re: **Wildlife Category:** Delegates, when filling out the Nature submissions for monthly competitions, please do **not** put "Wildlife" on the competition forms. Also, once again, all N4C representatives are requested not to put anything in the two boxes on the right (in the case of nature), or

for the remaining categories, to leave the right-hand column empty.

April 29: Remember to attend the **Yerba Buena Shoot Day**. Details on ad.

Foto Fanfare: The question of whether we should seek advertisers to help offset costs arose. This needs further discussion. By Board approval, the newsletter will also be distributed via e-mail and through the N4C web site. The editor handed out sheets to each delegate to take back to their respective clubs to sign up those who would be willing to receive the Fanfare by e-mail (in living color), rather than the hard copy (in b&w). To the extent that this is possible, it will save some reproduction costs. There was some concern about the privacy factors which will, hopefully, be accommodated.

Finally, the **Competition Committee** approved a change in the print rules: Only 1 HM will be awarded in each category, and only if there are enough entrants in that category to warrant HMs.

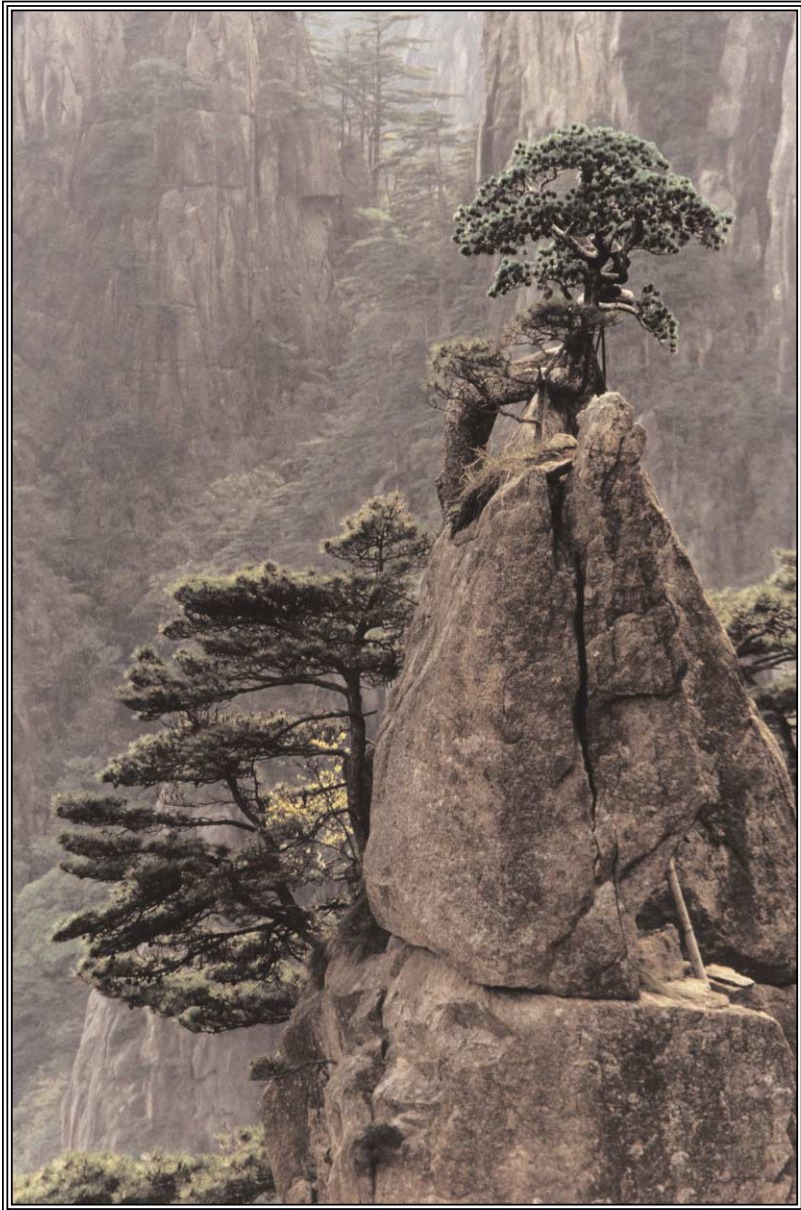
