



This should spread out the work and train a number of people in the job, as well. All prints for the **Annual Competition must be handed in by the December Board Meeting.**

PSA Chapter Rally: It was disappointing that there were only 75-80 attendees. In years past there had been as many as 400. Steve Traudt's presentations were praised.

FotoClave 2007: We still need an Equipment Chair and a Print Competition Chair.

Competition Committee: Dick Stahlke had proposed changes in red on the Division Definitions. They were adopted with the following changes:

- (1) Creative titles will be read in the future
- (2) Sequences of up to 4 images will be allowed in both Nature and Journalism Pls. There will be no sequences in special categories in the Print Division.
- (3) "Scientific names are not required," was added to the Nature section. The revised rules should be available soon on our website. Judges, in particular, as well as individuals, are urged to download them and review them.

Change in Levels Definitions: Since a number of clubs had not responded to the questionnaire, and there was concern about the use of the word "Beginner," added to the problem of the lengthy time it would take to change one of the submission programs, it was moved to table the discussion to the following year.

Responsibilities of Being a **Judge for Photography Club Competitions**

by Burr Preston

The term judge as used in the context of local photography club competition is misleading. This person is more meaningfully referred to as the evaluator or commentator.

Responsibilities

The club competition (or judging as it is frequently called) is intended to be an educational experience for everyone present, whether or not a person has entries in the competition. A short critique of each slide or print should identify and explain factors contributing to the success of the picture. For pictures less than perfect, constructive suggestions for improvement should be offered. The evaluator should encourage unique personal statements that do not echo those of other photographers.

This evaluation should always be friendly and positive in tone and accomplished with enthusiasm. An evaluator should emphasize what is successful in the picture, not what is wrong with the picture. The idea is to encourage people with their photography and to help them reach higher levels of proficiency, rather than to discourage them or, worst of all, turn them against their hobby or their photography club or both. Not only does this approach require skill, tact, positive thinking, and articulate speech which explains why in each case, it also requires enthusiasm and passion on the part of the evaluator. Artistic evaluation can never be other than subjective. There are no absolutes in art. Therefore the reasoning in reaching a conclusion is what is meaningful and educational, not the actual conclusion itself. For without the reasoning, the conclusion provides little or no help.

A final and least important job for the evaluator is to select those photographs deserving awards, or as it is more popularly stated, to choose the winners.







Eddie Soloway lived up to all expectations for a crowd of almost 150 at Laurel Heights Convention Center on Saturday, December 2. Sponsored by N4C, "A Natural Eye" elicited a new sense of seeing, punctuated by amusing stories. One that typified his approach:

"After the concert, a young student told the virtuoso, "Your violin makes such beautiful music!" Puzzled. the musician held the violin at arm's length and said, "My, but I don't hear a thing!"

His theme of creative photography had nothing to do with Photoshop; rather he attempted to inspire his listeners to find new ways to look at potential images. On workshop, when presented with small portfolios from attendees, he was often heard to say, "Seen that, seen that, seen that . . . Haven't seen that." Looking for new approaches.

Eddie left us with seven suggestions to think about:

- 1 Immerse yourself in what you can learn about your subject without a camera.
 - 2 Nail your technical skills.
- 3 Surround yourself with art, paintings, museum galleries, other sources that can inspire.
- 4 Find a buddy-someone who is willing to call it straight as to whether your image works or not.
- 5 Do SOMETHING with your images.
- 6. Stay in touch with Eddie
- 7 Enjoy the journey.
