The meeting was called to order at 7:40 pm.

Roll call: Role call was read by Leslie Crandell. All were present with the exception of Palo Alto,

Photochrome, Marin, President John Goyer, Webmaster Sam Berzin, and Amory Donaldson.

**Minutes**: Minutes were read. Tom Debley moved to approve minutes, Ed Mestre seconded the

motion. The motion was carried.

#### **Vice President:**

- Marin's N4C status was discussed. Joan Field recommended someone from N4C talking to the Marin club when their new president takes office in March.
- To speed up monthly board meetings it was suggested that emails be sent out to board members regarding issues during the month.
- Honors awards were discussed. Jane Postiglione said that the honor awards form is on the N4C website. She recommended that a committee be formed to retrieve previous award members. Leslie Crandell will check past January meeting minutes from 2000 to present to find past honor recipients. Teri Schoech suggested that an email be sent out to all members asking for past honor awards recipients to respond to complete past honor award history. Jane suggested that once we reconstruct the past information for the honor awards recipients that the page live on our N4C website.

#### Treasurer:

- Teri presented the monthly report and annual budget for 2011. She will make a revision on the
  annual budget to reflect the change in dues for Marin and present it again next month for voting.
   Tom Debley made a motion to approve the monthly budget and Joe Hearst seconded. Motion
  was carried.
- Dues are still needed from Berkeley, Millbrae, Peninsula and Rossmoor.

#### Secretary:

#### **Fundraiser Chair:**

Nothing to report.

#### **Judges Chair:**

- Joe Hearst announced the interclub judges for February-April. February pi judge will be Wendell Delano, print judge will be Stephen Weiss. March PI judge will be Barrie Bieler, prints will be John Goyer. April judges will be Kenna Mawk and Barbara Mallon, a decision had not been made on who would be judging prints or projected yet.
- Joe said that we need more interclub judges.

#### **Print Chair:**

- Dean McCoy thanked Gene Albright for getting the print spreadsheet straightened out.
- Dean has received a couple of 18x23 prints that were too large for competition. The largest print size that will be accepted for competition with matting is 16x20.
- Dean also mentioned that some prints are coming in that are too thick. The maximum thickness for mats and backing is one-quarter inch thick.
- We are moving to a new two-letter labeling system. Joan Field made a motion to change the
  nomenclature. Bob Wehrmeister seconded the motion. The motion was carried. The first letter will
  be the category and the second letter will be the level. Joe Hearst made a motion to change "CO" to
  P, and "MO" to "M". Teri seconded the motion.

The following nomenclature will apply to print labels:

"P" will replace "CO" for Pictorial prints. (Example, P/M for Pictorial Masters)

"M" will replace "MO for Monochrome prints.

"T" for Travel.

"C" for Creative.

"J" for Journalism

"S" for Sequence

"N" for Nature

Clubs may use up any preprinted labels that have made with "CO" and "MO" and then switch to the new labeling when their preprinted labels run out.

• Leslie Crandell will change the labeling requirements and projected image size in the competition rules.

#### **El Coordinator:**

- Gene asked N4C reps to please check submission entries before emailing them. He has received emails with the wrong club designation.
- Gene said that the Berkeley club is getting a new laptop and asked if N4C wanted to donate a
  couple of hundred dollars towards the laptop. Jim Cutler motioned to table the idea and Tom
  Debley seconded the motion. The motion was carried.

#### **Foto Fanfare Editor:**

Not present.

#### PSA:

- Joe Hearst said that the April 3<sup>rd</sup>, Sam Abell presentation in San Mateo is filling up rapidly.
- Joe brought a current edition of the PSA Journal to the meeting.
- Joe received the results from last years' Councils Challenge. N4C placed near the bottom but only submitted digital images. Burt Johnson received a Honorable Mention.
- Joe asked if we want to compete in this year's Councils Challenge. The deadline to register is April. Jim Cutler motioned to compete this year. Tom Debley seconded the motion. The motion was carried. Gene Albright will send the top winning images from the N4C Annual Competition to Joe to use in this year's Councils Challenge.

#### FotoClave:

- Joan Field said that the FotoClave committee will be meeting the Sunday of 2/20.
- The biggest challenge is finding a lead speaker for Saturday night and Sunday morning.
- 3 sessions are booked so far for FotoClave on Saturday afternoon. A Saturday session with Truman Holtzclaw speaking on wide angle photography is scheduled, Joe Hearst and Gene Morita will present their photos from Cuba, and Tom Debley will speak on how to improve Journalism photos. 3 more sessions are needed for Saturday afternoon.
- Jennifer Wu is booked as the Friday evening speaker at FotoClave.
- Dean McCoy was asked if he would handle prints for FotoClave. Dean said that if Gene Morita did not want the job that he would accept the responsibility.

#### Webmaster:

 Not present. Jim Cutler reported for Sam saying that more people need to post images on Slickpic for N4C website.

#### **Old Business:**

Nothing to report.

#### **New Business:**

Jane has been investigating new locations to hold the N4C annual banquet next January. Locations
