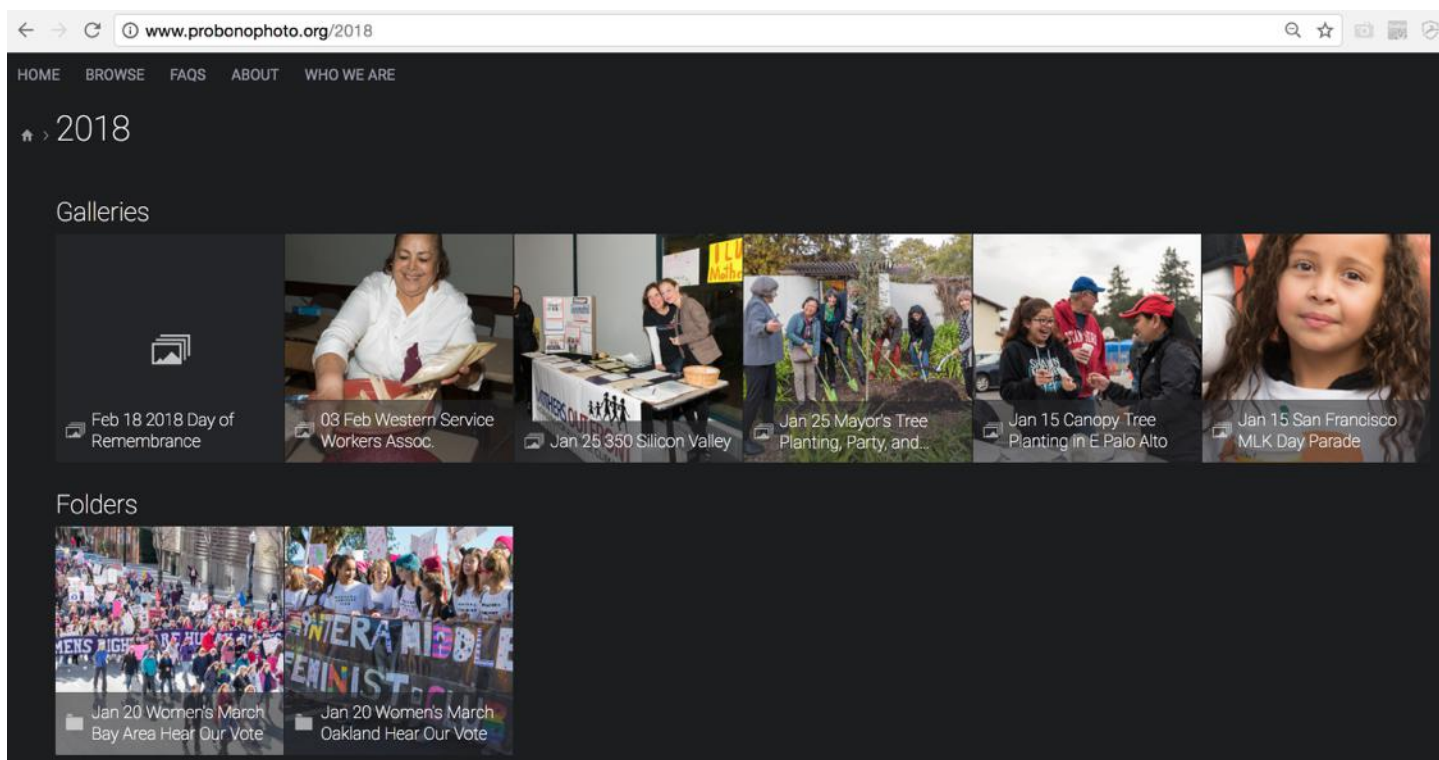
# Pro-Bono Photo
